#7 - My Responsibility

(Preparation vs Procrastination, Kingdom & Community - Sitters And Quitters, Work & Worship - don't expect to eat if you don't work, bring glory to God in the marketplace by the quality of your work, we are not meant to be fulfilled by always expecting a hand-out or hand-up; Your Worship on this side of Heaven can be fulfilling and meaningful, think of worship as a rehearsal for what you will be doing once you are promoted)
