Thicklin is an standout spokesperson addressing "End The Demand" of Human and Sex Trafficking as well as Project CEASE addressing HIV, PrEP and the Intersection Between Domestic Violence & HIV. His passion runs deep inside of his Social Justice work in "Dismantling Racism and the Role of Clergy. He has volunteered and worked for over 25 years with grass roots social services programs addressing parenting, mentorship and bridging the gap between Faith Communities, Domestic Violence and Mental Health.

Dr. Thicklin currently serves as the President of the Palm Beach County Clergy Alliance and is the Lead Director of the African American Domestic Peace Project West Palm Beach Chapter, and is the co-author of "Speaking of Faith: Domestic Violence Programs in the African American Church" in which he collaborated with the Institute on Domestic Violence in the African American Community out of the University of Minnesota and co-authored the recent released book Chosen: Find Purpose Man Up. In addition, he has developed and framed The Clergy Toolkit on Domestic & Sexual Violence in his collaboration with Palm Beach County Sexual Assault Response Team (SART).

Dr. Thicklin received his Bachelor of Ministry from **Southeastern Theological Seminary** and an Honorary Doctorate Degree (DD) from **Logos University in Jacksonville**, **Florida**. He studied Psychology and Sociology at South University and the University of Phoenix and is currently in pursuit of his Doctorate in Philosophy.

He has received many commendations including but not limited to The Governors Peace At Home Award, the Presidential Lifetime Achievement Award-Barak Obama, Palm Beach County Democratic Party Community Leadership Award and the African Diaspora Leaders & Unsung Heroes Award.
